



GRAND JETE STUDIO OF DANCE NEW POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR A SAFE RE-OPENING 2020

We are implementing sanitization protocols to protect your dancers/gymnasts as they come through the doors.

Please take a moment to read through our new policies and procedures to familiarize yourself and your dancer. We ask that parents of younger students have a conversation with their child prior to their first dance or gymnastics class back discussing the new rules and expectations regarding social distancing, wearing a mask and dancing/tumbling only in their 6 x 6 square.

- All waiting areas are closed. Parents and siblings must wait in their cars instead of inside the building. Parents of dancers 6 and under are encouraged to remain onsite in the parking lot the first week back to classes in case their dancer/gymnast has any separation or behavior issues. As we continue to navigate the CDC Guidelines we may open our waiting area for our Creative Dancers/Toddler Tumblers ONLY. (This exceeds the mandatory state guidelines)
- Parents must conduct their own health assessments of their dancer/gymnast prior to arriving at GJD. This includes taking temperatures and discussing all Covid-19 symptoms. Students may not enter the facility if they are exhibiting any symptoms or have been exposed to COVID-19.
- Upon entering the building, staff members will conduct a personal health assessment and input this information in a health log. We will have infrared no contact thermometers on site to check temperatures as students arrive. (This exceeds the mandatory state guidelines)
- Students should not enter the building until their exact class time. They may wait in their car outside upon arrival until their class time.
- Students need to arrive to the studio in their proper dance/gymnastics attire. There will be no changing allowed in the dressing rooms or bathrooms. Students are encouraged to wear a cover up to and from the building as desired. Street shoes will be placed on a rack located in the waiting area as we will not allow street shoes inside of the studios. (This exceeds the mandatory state guidelines)
- Anyone age 6 and up must wear a mask to enter the building. This includes all staff. STUDENTS WILL ONLY WEAR THEIR MASK WHILE ENTERING/EXITING THE BUILDING AND UTILIZING BATHROOM(S). STUDENTS WILL HAVE A DESIGNATED AREA TO PUT THEIR MASK WHILE DANCING/TUMBLING TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF OUR STUDENTS/STAFF. DANCE AND GYMNASTICS ARE PHYSICALLY DEMANDING SPORTS AND WE WANT TO MAKE SURE STUDENTS BREATHING IS NOT RESTRICTED WITH MASKS.



- Students are required to sanitize their hands upon entering the building. There will be a sanitizing station in the waiting area as well as hand sanitizer in each studio.
- Upon entering the classroom, students will be directed to stand on a yellow "X" in a 6 x 6 grid box. Dancers with water bottles will also be directed to a separate area to place their bottles. Drink breaks will be directed by the instructor and done one by one to ensure social distancing is maintained. Small bags only will be allowed in the studio and cell phones must be put away.



- Due to the size of our classrooms, the number of students per room depends on the number of 6 x 6 squares we can accommodate which varies per room.

Studio A: 14 Students, 1 Instructor

Studio B: 8 Students, 1 Instructor

Studio C: 11 Students, 1 Instructor

Studio D: 8 Students, 1 Instructor

- There will be no use of ballet barres, gymnastics/acro mats or props of any kind for the immediate future. We will evaluate this at a later time to begin use again.

- There will be NO EATING in the studio. Students should not bring any food or snacks into the building
- There will be a staff member in the waiting area at all times to monitor/help endorse social distancing during transitions between classes. This staff member will also be sanitizing all high contact public surfaces the entire time the studio is open to the students
- Classes will be dismissed 5 minutes early to allow time to sanitize between classes. 30 minutes classes will be dismissed at 25 minutes, 45 minutes classes at 40 minutes, 60 minute classes at 55 minutes etc.
- Students who have a break between classes must exit the building. They will need to wait in their cars or get picked up during their break and brought back.
- The lost and found has been removed. Try your best not to bring extra items to be left behind.
- There will be no use of fans in the classrooms. The studio will cool the classrooms by air conditioning only.
- If parents have any questions with which they need staff assistance, they are encouraged to call the studio at 610-393-5225 or email the studio at grandjeteoffice@yahoo.com instead of entering the facility in person. The office will be closed for unannounced walk-in questions. If a parent needs to come into the building for a payment or to sign a document, they should call the office first to set up a time to come in.

In confederation of the Minor's use of Facilities and participation of Programs I, in my legal capacity as parent/guardian of Minor, agree on behalf of myself and Minor that Grand Jete Studio of Dance LLC, it's officers, directors, agents, employees, volunteers, insurers and representatives ("Releasees") will not be liable for any personally injury, property damage, disability, death, sickness or disease incurred by Minor, however occurring including, but not limited to, claims of negligence of Releasees. I understand that Minor and I will be solely responsible for any loss or damage, including personal injury, property damage, disability, death, sickness or disease sustained from use of Facilities and participation in Programs.

I further agree, in my legal capacity as the parent/guardian of Minor, on behalf of Minor, myself and any and all legal successors and proxies, to release and **HEREBY DO RELEASE, WAIVE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE**. Releases from any causes of action, claims, suits, liabilities or demands of any nature whatsoever including, but in no way limited to, claims of negligence, which Minor, myself, and any legal successors and proxies may have now or in the future, against Releasees on account of personal injury, property damage, disability, death, sickness, disease or accident of any kind, arising out of or in any way related to the use of Facilities or participation of Programs, whether that participation is supervised or unsupervised, however the injure or damage occurs, including, but not limited to, the negligence of Releasees.

In further consideration of the use of Facilities and participation of Programs, I, in my legal capacity as parent/guardian of Minor, agree on behalf of myself and Minor to **INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS** Releasees from any and all causes of action, claims, demands, losses, suits, liabilities or costs of any nature whatsoever, including claims of negligence arising out of or in any way related to the use of Facilities and participation in Programs.
